- Every effort will be made to get you the plants you select, but some species are more limited than others. **Get your orders in quickly! First orders in, first served.**
- Pick up location is at The Nature Conservancy's Kankakee Sands Native Plant Nursery
- Suggested donation of \$1 per plant
- **Please only come to pick up your plants at the time you listed on your order form.** Your plants will not be ready until that time.

When you come on **Saturday, May 29** to pick up your plants:

- **Come to The Nature Conservancy's Kankakee Sands Nursery, located at 1492 W CR 250 N, Morocco, IN, across from North Newton H.S.**
- Come only at the time that you listed on your order form.
- Park in the parking lot.
- Follow social distancing guidelines.
- Wearing a mask is required.
- We will set your plants on a table for you to retrieve.
- Once you see your plants, you can make a donation by cash or check into the bucket. **Change will not be given.** Checks can be made out to "Friends of the Sands".
- If you are unable to get the plants from the table, we will carry the plants to your car and place them in your trunk.
- Bring a box to transport your plants. Some boxes will be available, but we may run out.
